Recognition of Graduates

Honors College graduates are recognized in the following ways:

- ❖ The graduates are honored at the Bowers Medallion Ceremony & Reception hosted by the Honors College each semester.
- ❖ The honors graduate’s official transcript is marked “With Highest Honors” or “With Honors.”
- ❖ The honors graduate receives special recognition in the commencement program denoting his or her distinction.
- ❖ The honors graduate receives a Bowers Medallion to wear at commencement.
- ❖ The honors graduate receives an Honors College stole to wear at commencement.
- ❖ The name of the honors graduate and his or her distinction is announced on the platform at the Bowers Medallion Ceremony & Reception
- ❖ The honors graduate is awarded a special certificate of recognition.
