ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- 1 Submit an online application**
→ visit shsu.edu/apply.
- 2 Pay the application fee in the self-service portal**
→ visit shsu.edu/checkstatus.
This is a non-refundable \$50 fee.
- 3 Submit transcripts**
→ Ask your high school to send an official transcript with GPA, date of expected graduation and graduation plan to SHSU. Transfer students send official transcripts from all institutions attended. (Code: 003606)
- 4 Submit optional test scores**
→ If you choose to send your test scores, contact the appropriate testing agency to request submission to SHSU. (SAT school code 6643; ACT school code 4162)
