**Class Competition:** The class with the highest attendance rate at each campus will win a Popcorn with the Principal party in January. Winners will be announced in December.

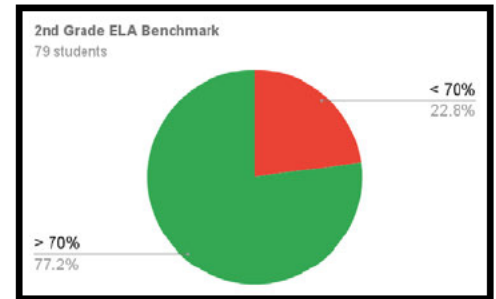
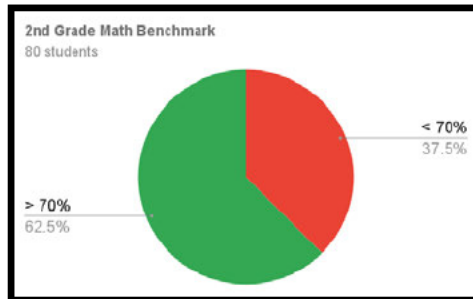
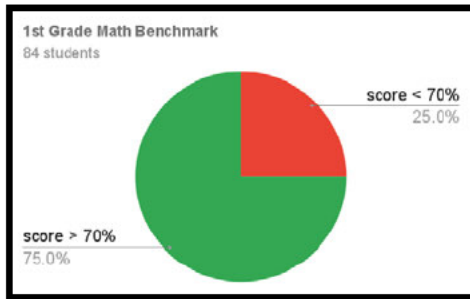

# District Data Review: 1st Nine Weeks

During the week of September 19-22, all students in grades 1-6 completed benchmark testing for NW1.

Results are shown below:



\*NOTE: First grade does not take an ELA benchmark during NW1. This is the first year we have administered an ELA benchmark in NW1 for second grade. (Historically, that hasn't occurred until NW2.)

Students in STAAR grades (3-6) complete benchmark tests online with STAAR practice items. These tests are scored using STAAR conversion charts, which follow "passing" cut points that are lower than 70%. *Sample below:*
