School of Nursing Admissions Requirements:

- For admission Fall 2024 and Spring 2025:
 - o Completion of 7 of the 9 Nursing Prerequisite Courses with a GPA ≥ 3.0
 - Overall GPA ≥ 3.0 (Additional Texas Core Requirements + Nursing Prerequisite Courses)
- For admission for Fall 2025 and thereafter:
 - All 9 <u>Nursing Prerequisite Courses</u> must be complete with a GPA ≥ 3.0 prior to application submission.
 - Texas Core requirements must be complete with a GPA ≥ 3.0 before anticipated start date.
- Any grade below "C" must be replaced before the application deadline (applicable courses).
- Science courses (BIOL & CHEM) must be taken within 7 years of the application deadline.
 - Excludes LVN-BSN and RN-BSN.
 - Science courses must be 4 credits each.
- Only 2 graded attempts in a Lab Science course are allowed. A 3rd graded attempt automatically
 disqualifies student from application, apart from course expiration (taken > 7 years prior).
- Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) license is strongly recommended (not required).
- Preference is given to applicants with:
 - Course hours at SHSU
 - MATH 1370- Intro to Biomedical Statistics
 - o CNA, CMA, EMT, Paramedic license/certificate (with 6 months experience)
 - Previous completion of a bachelor's or master's Degree
 - Veterans
 - Completion of Prerequisite Courses prior to application submission

School of Nursing Admissions Requirements:

TEAS EXAM:

- Minimum Overall Score must be ≥ 70
- **Sub-scores** must be ≥ 55
 - o Reading and Math sub-scores will be used when calculating the rank.
- Given multiple test scores, choose 1 score report to use.
- If testing at SHSU, register for the TEAS exam at www.atitesting.com or www.atitesting
- Upload Individual Performance Profile in application.
- Must be taken within 2 years of the application deadline.

June 1 – August 1, 2024

Helpful Information to Keep in Mind

The following information is not required at admission but is needed before the start of the second semester of nursing school:

- Proof of comprehensive health insurance (required each year for clinical placements).
- Background check. Background checks revealing offenses may prevent students from completing necessary clinical coursework.
- Some clinical settings require proof of citizenship or official residency status from nursing students. If a
 student does not have required documentation to establish sufficient proof of citizenship or official
 residency status (e.g., driver's license, passport, visa, employment authorization documentation, Texas
 identification card), it is very likely they will not be able to complete necessary clinical coursework.
 Students who do not complete clinical coursework will be unable to earn the BSN, resulting in the
 potential loss of significant time and money.

- Immunizations are required by our clinical partners, may exceed CDC recommendations, and follow the Texas Administrative Code, Title 25, Part 1, Chapter 97, Subchapter B Rule 97.64 and 97.65.
 - Proof of immunizations is required to remain in the nursing program. Plan accordingly as some vaccine series, such as Hepatitis B, may require 6 months to complete.
 - Requirements are subject to change based on clinical site.

*The School of Nursing Requirements are subject to change.

- Complete Nursing CAS application (will require submission of official transcript(s)) and TEAS scores.
