Students must earn a 2.0 minimum overall GPA in all coursework, overall major GPA in all major coursework, SHSU GPA in all coursework, and SHSU major GPA in all major coursework.

The total hours reflect the inclusion of two lower-division courses -- CRIJ 2362 and CRIJ 2364 -- in the Criminal Justice Concentration.

If the student does not have prior credit for CRIJ 2362 and CRIJ 2364, the total hours increase to 126.

A total of a minimum of 36 advanced hours (3000-4000 level classes) must be taken. These hours may come in part from the concentration and required internship or mentorship. Additional elective hours will be required to complete this requirement.
