




As a result of participating in Welcome Week events...




95% would likely attend future events hosted by the Department of Student Activities




TOTAL EVENTS ATTENDED

TRANSFER STUDENTS

43% of respondents identified as transfer students

The top three universities that students transferred from were:

- Lone Star College
- Blinn College
- San Jacinto Community College

Of the 180 transfer students respondents, 62% indicated that the Welcome Week program aided their transition to SHSU.

FIRST-GENERATION STUDENTS

First-generation students are students who are the first in their family to attend college.

49% of respondents self-identified as first-generation.
